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ORDER

Per. Justice Vivek Rusia

The petitioner has filed an instant writ petition seeking revaluation of his answer sheet in the subject of Human Anatomy & Physiology of Diploma course in Medical Lab Technician in the examination conducted by M.P. Medical Science University, Jabalpur.

2. The petitioner, who is a student of Diploma in Medical Lab Technician, secured 25 marks in the subject of Human Anatomy & Physiology of DMLT Examination conducted in April, 2025. According to the petitioner, he has correctly given answers to Questions No.1B & 1C, but he has been wrongly awarded zero-zero, thereby he has secured a total of only 25 marks out of a total of 100 marks. Hence, this petition.



3. The minimum passing marks in the subject is 36 out of 100 marks. The petitioner has secured only 25 marks and thus is short by 11 marks. Even if two (02) marks are awarded to the petitioner, he will not cross the passing marks. Even otherwise, there is no provision for revaluation in M.P. Medical Science University under the Regulation framed for conducting the examination in question.

4. Therefore, there is no case for interference. The writ petition is dismissed accordingly.
