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ORDER

Per. Vivek Rusia, Acting Chief Justice

The petitioner is son of the respondent no.4/Anil Sonkar. The respondent no.5 and 6 are his uncle. The allegation of the petitioner is that the respondent no.4, 5 and 6 have detained their mother, who happens to be grand mother of the petitioner.

2. The petitioner has filed the photograph to show that he was assaulted and thrown out from the house by his own parents and uncle. This is purely a family dispute between the petitioner and respondents. There is no illegal detention of a mother with the son and parents. So far assault is concerned, the petitioner has already made a complaint to the police authorities (Annexure P-2). Since, it is not a case of illegal detention;



therefore, writ of habeus corpus is not a remedy. The petitioner is free to avail other remedy available under the law. Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of.
