UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. We have been informed that the appellants have been incarcerated for nearly 18 years.
3. Taking into consideration that the appellants have been incarcerated for a period of almost 18 years, we are inclined to grant bail to them.
4. Accordingly, the appellants are directed to be released on bail, during the pendency of the appeals, on such terms and conditions as may be imposed by the Trial Court.
5. Application (I.A. No.202046/2025 in CrI.A No.1872/2024) for bail is, accordingly, disposed of.
6. Post the matters in the month of February, 2026.
7. However, liberty is granted to the respondents to file an appropriate application for cancellation of bail, if the appellants are found to be violating either the conditions imposed by the Trial Court or are found to be involved in any other offence.
