ORDER

1. Learned Counsel for the NMCG submits that the reports have been

sought from the States and State Pollution Control Boards from where

River Ganga or its tributaries are flowing. These reports are awaited and

he seeks 04 weeks' time to file the comprehensive report.

2. The NMCG will also disclose in that report if the tapping of storm water

drains is permissible as a permanent measure because such tapping

will not only affect the storm water discharge network but will also

result in over flowing of these storm water drains if the sewage drains

are connected with the same and it will also violate the orders of the

court prohibiting discharge of sewage to the storm water drain and will

result in over flooding of the STPs during the rainy season and

consequential flowing of untreated sewage in the rivers and natural

water course.

3. The NMCG will also disclose if any STP has been permitted on the flood

plain zones of River Ganga or its tributaries and if any such STP has

been financed by the NMCG. It will also disclose the stretches of River

Ganga and its tributaries where the flood plains have been demarcated.

Let this report be filed within 04 weeks.
