It is fairly submitted on behalf of the petitioners that a Bill has been introduced in the Assembly upon reducing the court-fees to be charged both for writ petitions and writ appeals.

2. Further, the new Writ Rules published by this court grant exemption in matters where several petitioners join in a single petition.

3. Since sufficient concession by way of reduction of court-fees may already have been granted by the government, let these matters appear after the vacation and await the passage of the Bill in the Assembly.

4. Two of these petitions pertain to court fess paid for obtaining succession certificates. There was a serious anomaly in the sense that

the quantum of court-fees was much greater than what was required to be paid for obtaining probate. Even such aspect of the matter has been addressed by the State Government and has been incorporated in the Bill by providing for a maximum ad valorem fee.
