Heard Sri Peeyush Kumar Pathak, learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Standing Counsel appearing on behalf of respondent nos.1 to 3 and Sri Jai Bahadur Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent no.4.

The instant writ petition has been filed praying for a mandamus commanding respondent no.3 Nagar Ayukt Nagar Nigam, Saharanpur to decide the representation of the petitioner.

In the representation, which is dated 29.8.2021, the petitioner has prayed for cancellation of certain notices issued to two other persons, namely, Ramesh s/o Bichua and Billu s/o Ramchandra. The petitioner has also requested the Nagar Ayukt to renew his licence relating to retail business of meat.

The petitioner alleges that he was holder of licence of retail meat shop since a long time. The respondent Nagar Nigam on basis of notice issued to Ramesh and Billu, which has no concern with petitioner, is declining to renew the licence of the petitioner.

It is evident from the record that the licence of the petitioner has not been renewed on basis of office report that meat shop of the petitioner is situated within a radius of 50 meters from a temple and as per guidelines issued by Government, the same is not permissible.

The petitioner has not challenged the action of the respondents

in declining to renew his licence.

In such circumstances, we find no good reason to direct the authorities to decide his representation for cancelling a notice issued to some other persons or for renewing his licence.

Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed.
