The aforesaid two appeals originated from a common order dated 9th February, 2022; wherein a series of directions were passed not only on the Committee constituted by the Division Bench for conducting an enquiry but also to stop the salary of the candidates who were appointed pursuant to the recruitment process initiated in the year 2016.

The Division Bench in an earlier appeal set aside the order of the Single Bench when the identical direction was passed stopping the salary of the candidates and directed the enquiry to be conducted and the report to be submitted in order to unearth the truth and the illegalities committed by the authorities who are in the helm of affairs. The Division Bench further directed that further orders are required to be passed on the basis of the report to be submitted by the committee so constituted for such purposes.

The impugned order would discern the reimposition of the order, which was interfered by the Division Bench and, therefore, we find that prima facie case has been made out for interim order.

Accordingly, there shall be a stay of operation of the impugned order dated 9th February, 2022 for a period of one week from date or until further order/orders of this Court, whichever is earlier.

Let this matter be listed on 21st February, 2022 to be taken up at the first sitting of the Court.

The appellants are directed to communicate this order to the non-appearing respondents.
