ORDER

- 1. Issue raised in the present petition filed in public interest litigation is pertaining to the medical facilities available in the State Government Hospitals.
- 2. One of the issue raised is that on an inspection made by the Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister and Health Minister, medicines worth crores of rupees were found to be lying in store, which had expired. Besides this certain other issues have also been raised.
- 3. Another important aspect which has been raised at the time of hearing is spread of dengue fever in the city, for which apparently effective steps are not being taken to control or prevent the same.
- 4. We have requested Sri Namit Sharma, learned Counsel for the Nagar Nigam, Lucknow to apprise the Court about the steps taken for control and prevention of dengue fever.
- 5. Learned counsel for the State to apprise the Court about the upgradation of medical facilities and especially the availability of Plasma

for the patients who may need the same. He shall also apprise the Authorities to support the local administration wherever required in providing the man-power or machines or the funds for the aforesaid purpose.

- 6. The Court be also apprised of the fact as to why IT solutions are not being utilised for purchase and use of medicines in different Government Hospitals in the State.
- 7. Adjourned to October 21, 2022.
