## WRIT PETITION No.2510 of 2023

**ORDER:** (Per the Hon'ble the Chief Justice Ujjal Bhuyan)

Heard Mr. Dushyant Dave, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner.

- 2. This Court had not issued notice to the respondent, but we find that Mr. Ashok Anand Kumar, learned Senior Counsel representing Mr. L.Arvind Reddy, learned Counsel for the respondent, has voluntarily appeared on behalf of the respondent on instructions.
- 3. This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the following relief:

"For the reasons stated in the accompanying affidavit, it is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble Court in the interest of Justice be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ of Mandamus or Writ in the nature of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction, commanding the Hon'ble Governor of Telangana, the respondent herein to forthwith approve the proposed date of Budget 2023-24 as requested by the Finance (BG) Department in File No. (C.No. 1835925-A/16/A1/BG2023) and to grant further

approval in this regard as may be sought from time to time and pass such other order or orders as may be deemed fit

and proper in the circumstances of the case."

4. In the course of the hearing and following a positive

interaction between the two learned counsel during the

intervening lunch break, it appears that the matter is being

sorted out.

5. We hope and trust the matter is resolved between

the high constitutional functionaries keeping in mind the letter

and spirit of the Constitution. We make it clear that we have

not expressed any opinion on merit as well as on the

maintainability of the writ petition.

6. Writ Petition is accordingly closed. No costs.

7. Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, in this

Writ Petition shall stand closed.
