Rajasthan NIA Special Court Convicts 1 terrorist in ISIS Jaipur Case

Yesterday (20.02.2023), Ld. Special Judge, Special Court for NIA Cases, Jaipur, Rajasthan convicted an accused in RC 5/2016/NIA/DLI under Section 120-B IPC, and Sections 13, 38 and 39 of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act for 07 years RI with fine.

- 2. The case pertains to promotion of ideology of the ISIS, a proscribed terror organisation, and inciting others over social media platforms like Facebook, WhatsApp and Telegram, to join the ISIS for carrying out terror activities in India.
- 3. The details of the accused convicted are as follows:
 Mohammed Sirajuddin @ Siraj @ Mohammed Siraj s/o Mohammed Sarwar, r/o of Jawahar Nagar, Jaipur and permanent resident of Gulbarga, Karnataka.
- 4. During the investigations, the accused Mohammed Sirajuddin @ Siraj @ Mohammed Siraj was found inciting the youth to carry out acts of violence and terror. He was using online chats and messages to advocating and spreading the ideology of the Islamic State in various parts of the world. He also arranged and assisted in organising online discussions & meetings among active ISIS operatives to plan & execute acts of violence & terrorism.
