Accused Jagdish Tytler is present (through VC).

Matter is listed for scrutiny of documents/ further proceedings.

Ld. Counsel for the Accused submits that he need some more time for scrutiny of the documents and he shall move a formal application u/s 207 Cr.P.C., if required, with advance copy to Ld. PP for CBI. Heard. Allowed in the interest of justice.

At this stage, Ld. Counsel for the Complainant has objected to the appearance of Accused Jagdish Tytler through VC stating that no formal application has been moved by his Counsel. However, no merits are found in the objections raised by Ld. Counsel for the Complainant on account of Office Order of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi bearing No. 01/RG/DHC/2023 dated 05.06.2023, wherein it has been specifically ordered that:

“..... that the District Courts in Delhi, shall permit any of the parties and/or their counsel to appear through hybrid/video-conferencing mode during

Court proceedings, without there being any requirement of a prior request for the same.”

Accordingly, the objections raised by Ld. Counsel for the Complainant are rejected.
