Vide separate judgment announced in open Court, the accused Sajjan Kumar is given benefit of doubt and acquitted for the offences under Section 109 IPC read with Sections 147, 148, 149, 153A, 295, 302, 436 IPC and also for the offence under Section 153A IPC. The accused Ved Prakash Pial @ Veedu Pradhan and Brahmanand Gupta @ Gupta Telwala are acquitted for the offences under Section 109 read with Sections 147, 148, 149, 153A, 295, 302 and 436 IPC and also for the substantive offences under Sections 147, 148, 149 IPC and under Section 436 read with Section 149 IPC; Section 295 read with Section 149 IPC and Section 302 read with Section 149 IPC.

The accused Sajjan Kumar is in custody though on bail in this case.

The accused persons are also directed to furnish a bond under the provisions of Section 437A Cr.P.C.
