1. Mr. Kakade, learned Government Pleader has tendered a letter dated 18th December 2023 addressed to him by the Deputy

Legal Advisor-cum-Deputy Secretary, Law and Judiciary Department, Mantralaya, Mumbai. A photocopy of the said letter is taken on record. Mr. Kakade states that 348 new posts were created after recommendations of the NCMSC Committee taking the sanctioned strength from 2012 to 2360. He states that the NCMSC Committee had recommended creation of 3211 posts of judges, and that out of 3211 posts, 348 posts were created.

2. Today, Mr. Kakade states that both the Committees i.e. Sub-Committee of High Power Committee as well as the High Power Committee have granted approval for creation of the remaining posts i.e. 2863 posts. He states that the approval for creation of posts and of the supporting staff has also been granted and that both the said approvals will be placed before the Cabinet, at the earliest. He assures us that as soon as the proposals are placed before the Cabinet, a decision will be taken at the earliest.

3. Stand over to 8th January 2024.
