Heard learned counsel for the applicant, learned A.G.A. for the State-respondent.

It is alleged in the prosecution case that eleven persons including the applicant were candidate for selection process held by U.P. Police Recruitment Board, for the post of Sub-Inspector. It is further alleged that co-accused Ritesh Kumar did not submit his original document for scrutiny and subsequently, it came to light that another co-accused Ajay Chauhan had taken Rs.15,00,000/- from him for getting him recruited and he had retained his original documents and was demanding a further sum of Rs.3,50,000/- for returning his original document.

Learned counsel for the applicant submits that co-accused Ritesh Kumar and Ajay Chauhan have been enlarged on bail. Applicant has no previous criminal history. He submits that it's a case of false implication.

*Per contra*, learned A.G.A. has opposed the contention and has submitted that it's not a case of false implication; during investigation complicity of the applicant in aiding the candidates to pass the examination by illegal means has been found. He has received various amounts in his bank account on different dates. The co-accused have been granted regular bail. The offence committed by the applicant is against general public where in a public exam, he has committed cheating and forgery and documentary evidence regarding his complicity have been collected by the Investigating Officer.

Perused the record.

On due consideration to the submissions advanced by the learned A.G.A., *prima facie* it does not appear to be a case of false implication; complicity of the applicant is evident from perusal of the case diary hence, the application being devoid of merits is accordingly *dismissed*.
