ORDER

Leave granted.

The appellants have been arraigned as accused in Case Crime No.211 of 2022 dated 19.09.2022 registered at Police Station – Kotwali, District - Rampur for the offences punishable under Sections 409, 411, 201, 120B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 2/3 of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case which include the period of incarceration undergone by the appellants, and that the chargesheet has already been filed, we are inclined to set aside the impugned order and grant bail to the appellants.

Accordingly, the impugned order stands set aside and the appellants are granted bail, subject to the terms and conditions which are to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.

The Trial Court shall also impose a condition to the effect that the appellants shall cooperate with the conduct of the trial till its conclusion and shall not make any attempt to influence or win over the witnesses.

Liberty is also granted to the respondent-State to seek for cancellation of bail in case of violation of any of the conditions imposed upon the appellants.

We further make it clear that the Trial Court is at liberty to proceed with the trial, notwithstanding the conduct of the parties.

The appeals stand allowed accordingly, on the aforesaid terms.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
